Once you have the app downloaded, each Sunday when you arrive at church, open your ShelbyNext App and click "Check In" ("allow" it to know your location). Then click on "who" you are checking in, choose the worship service, then "Done."

FROM THE PEACE AND JUSTICE TASKFORCE Spartanburg is one of 20 communities and one of only three in the Southeast participating in the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation's \$72 million Just Futures Initiative, which is creating a national network of ambitious humanities-based projects that address racial inequality in bold and imaginative ways. Each community's project – including Spartanburg's – is designed to help us understand our past, make meaning of our present, and develop the conditions required to create socially just futures. Currently, Spartanburg community members are working to build "a bridge of trust strong enough to carry the truth," research both the nature and origins of our current racial inequalities and identify promising "leverage points" in our community systems (places where intentional application of resources or changes in policies and practices can produce meaningful progress toward the vision of a just future Spartanburg).
