WORLD DAY OF PRAYER - FRIDAY, MARCH 4 World Day of Prayer is a global, ecumenical movement of Christian women who pray and act for peace and justice. On the first Friday of March every year, Presbyterian Women join their prayers and voices with women in more than 170 countries and regions. Through World Day of Prayer, women affirm that prayer and action are inseparable and have immeasurable influence in the world. Each year, a different country that participates in World Day of Prayer serves as host country, writing the worship materials and compiling resources about their region's culture, history, and faith traditions to educate women in other parts of the world. For 2022, these materials have been written by the women of England, Wales, and Northern Ireland (https://wdp-usa.org). This Friday, March 4, the Chapel of First Presbyterian Church will be open (9am-5pm) for anyone to come, sit, and pray.
