COMMUNION TODAY Take some time prior to the service and investigate your Individual Communion Set. Depending on which type of Communion Set you have, the opening instructions are a little different.



Standard set:

- 1) Hold the edges of the cup, remove the clear cellophane to expose the wafer.
- 2) Hold the edges of the cup, remove the foil to expose the juice.

Chalice type:

- 1) Open bottom seal to access the wafer.
- 2) Open top seal to access the juice.
