And, appropriately enough, the theme for our time together is:

"Rejoicing in our Story."

In addition to welcoming back Drs. Todd Jones, David Renwick, and Tom Evans (three of our past senior pastors) for a special Sunday school hour and worship service at 11:00am, we will also gather for lunch on the front lawn afterwards. I hope you will not only mark your calendars and plan on attending but also take time to consider where God is calling **you** to add your story to the life and faith of the church today.

#### Witness Season 2023: THANK YOU!

On behalf of the International Missions Committee, please accept our heartfelt gratitude for your generosity in funding the 2023 Witness Season Project, a water filtration system for the Iglesia Presbiteriana-Reformada Santa Clara, our sister congregation in Cuba. As I write in mid-March, the total amount raised has exceeded our goal of \$30,000 by nearly \$12,000, giving us a nice cushion for future maintenance of the filtration system! A First Presbyterian team consisting of Kevin DeMark, Holt Andrews, and David Foy is scheduled to attend the Clean Water U training offered by Living Waters for the World in late April. Afterward, we look forward to being able to set a timeline for the onsite installation as soon as we are able to arrange it.

Thank you for participating in this important project that will provide clean drinking water for the church as well as the surrounding community, greatly enhancing the quality of life for many Santa Clara residents. It brings me great joy to be associated with a congregation that so generously shares its resources with our less-fortunate brothers and sisters, both local and international.
