Last month, the pastoral and program staff gathered in Lake Lure, NC for a two-day retreat. The focus of our time together this year was on team building and cultivating meaningful connections amongst our group. The latter was especially important given the fact that there are several new faces that have joined our church staff in recent weeks and months – mine included!

One of the exercises our facilitator led us through involved about sixty cards spread out on a table. Each card had a picture and a word printed on the front. For example, one card had a picture of footprints going up a giant sand dune with the word "perseverance" printed on it. Other cards had pictures with corresponding words such as Joy, Fear, Belief, Opportunity, Stuck, Learning, Gratitude, Journey, Change, etc. Each of us was asked to pick a card from the table that described where we feel like we

currently are in our lives. We then went around the circle and shared about why we selected the card in our hands.

It was a fascinating and meaningful activity. Not only did it help us get to know one another at a deeper level, but it also stimulated rich conversation as we recognized parts of our own story in the stories of others. And the whole time, I kept wondering to myself:

What card would we - as a church - pick up off the table?

Now I cannot answer that question for all of you, but I can tell you the card that I would pick in response to that question. Specifically, there was one near the middle of the table with a picture of a child's smiling face and the word: *Hopeful*. Friends, I am so *hopeful* for the future of First Presbyterian. Whether in our ministries of care and compassion, in meals being served on Thursday nights, in any one of our weekly Bible studies, in a busload of youth headed off to Montreat, or in

the small army of children coming forward for the children's moment most every Sunday – the love of Jesus Christ is being felt and freely shared everywhere we turn.

And so, as we look ahead to the fall, I invite you to find (or re-find) your place here at FPC. Come join with others in your church family as we seek to grow in faith and serve others in love. After all, there is nothing more *hopeful* than a body of believers striving to live out the hope we share in Jesus Christ in all that we do.
