- An adult must accompany children under the age of 8.
- No glass or alcoholic beverages.

- Proper footwear is required.

- Report damaged equipment to the church office.
- Please help keep this area clean - take your trash when you leave.

## Playground Party Guidelines

We are delighted you are considering using the Playground for your child's party. **Please call the church office (864-583-4531) to schedule your event.** This enables us to confirm that there will be no conflicts with events such as worship services or playground maintenance.

Please note that scheduling a party does not close the playground to others. On the day of your party, if another family arrives and wants to use the playground, please warmly welcome them into the space. Additionally, we will try to avoid conflicts, but it is possible that more than one party may take place on the same day/time.

There is no FPC Staff Support for parties on the playground. Please clean up the area after you leave and take any trash with you. Bathrooms may not be available on the requested day/time. During church office hours, members may bring their access card and use it to access the facilities.
